

TRANSNATIONAL PROJECT MEETING

On 24 and 25 April 2023, the Safe Last Mile Delivery project partners met in Athens, Greece for an in-person Transnational Project Meeting. Hosted by Exelia, the agenda included presentations and discussions of the project's expected results, as well as presentations from local last mile delivery and logistics stakeholders.

The discussion points for the TPM were divided into different sessions relevant to the project work plan and results. These included: the design of the project's curriculum structure, training and assessment material, the development of the handbook for in-house mentors and trainers, the development of the learner's e-book, the online course on sustainable and safe cycle last mile deliveries, preparation and deployment of VOOC content and functionalities and dissemination and communication activities.

The TPM also had guest speakers from local businesses, including Mrs. Stavroula Papadopoulou, co-owner of local vegan food store TO BAZAKI; Mr. Vangelis Makris of the Road Safety Institute, *Panos Mylonas*; Mr. Vasileios Pappas, Planning and Optimization Lead with Dixons South-East Europe; and Ms. Ioanna Pagoni, Vice President and Transport Engineer at HITE-Hellenic Institute of Transport Engineers.

Over the course of the two days, partners delivered presentations for each session, addressing all aspects of the activities already completed since the second meeting in Brussels and the ones that are planned for Semester 3, according to the provisions of the project application form.
